Helpful tips:

- ➤ If you wish to adapt this curriculum to account for transferred credit or variances in the total number of credits per semester, it is recommended that you complete the required Music Production and Music Business courses first, as these serve as a foundation for the electives that comprise the major.
- For all courses except OLSOC-180, and OIDMS-480 make sure that you are selecting a different course each time. General Education courses can be completed in any order and can be substituted for one another in your academic plan in the event that you have received transfer credit to fulfill one of these areas.
- ➤ In planning your elective courses, make sure that you are paying close attention to the prerequisite requirements for the 300/400 Level Music Electives courses you would like to complete. We strongly encourage students to work closely with their advisors to develop a plan for their degree early on in the program. Please also reference the Recommended Foundational Courses by Area of Interest below for additional guidance.
- ➤ Keep in mind that for those courses that have OLMSC-130: Applied Math for Musicians as a prerequisite, you will either need to complete the course or receive the requisite score on the math placement test regardless of transfer credit.
- > For this major, Study Abroad is recommended in semester 3 through semester 6 for those interested students.
