Helpful tips:

- ➤ If you wish to adapt this curriculum to account for transferred credit or variances in the total number of credits per semester, it is not recommended that you alter the order of the Required Concentrate courses as these have been arranged based on course prerequisites.
- For General Music Elective courses, Voice Elective courses, and General Education courses, make sure that you are selecting a different course from the list each time. General Education courses can be completed in any order and can be substituted for one another in your academic plan in the event that you have received transfer credit to fulfill one of these areas.
- > Students enrolled in the voice major will begin their Private Lessons at level 1. During the first week of the semester, their instructor will assess their proficiency and determine if they should be placed in a different level. If the student has completed undergraduate-level private voice instruction at a regionally accredited institution, they may be eligible to receive transfer credit for the levels they place out of. If the student does not have credit-bearing private voice instruction or their coursework does not meet the necessary criteria for transfer, the student will be awarded prior learning credit for the levels they place out of.
- For this major, applicable coursework is limited in Study Abroad. Those interested students are encouraged to seek advising early on in their program.
